

**CHIPPEWA COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION
JOB DESCRIPTION**

TITLE: Equipment Operator V

POSITION SUMMARY:

Under the supervision of a Maintenance Foreman or a District Foreman, an employee in this classification performs work related to the maintenance of roadways, buildings, and properties within the jurisdiction of the Chippewa County Road Commission.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

As a highly skilled and experienced maintenance worker an employee in this classification works in all aspects of roadway and bridge maintenance operations. Employees in this classification perform their work operations with a minimum of supervision. An employee in this classification may be required to perform all aspects of the Equipment Operator III and IV classifications.

Employees in this classification are fully qualified operators of heavy equipment such as but not limited to: motor grader, front-end loader, asphalt distributor, roller, snowblower, chip spreader, backhoe, earth mover, grade-all type equipment, cranes or draglines, bulldozers, and other specialized pieces of equipment used in heavy construction and maintenance. Employees in this classification perform other functions as may be assigned from time to time.

The duties stated here are intended to describe the general nature and level of work being performed by persons assigned this classification. They are not to be construed as an exhaustive list of all job duties performed by personnel so classified.

ESSENTIAL JOB ELEMENTS AND PHYSICAL DEMANDS (ADA):

- Physical Mobility - Ability to walk extended distances and climb stairs or ramps to access Commission and other work related locations and facilities.
- Vision and Sight - Ability to read instructions, directions, and similar written information in letters, memoranda, forms and other documents.
- Hearing/Speaking - Ability to converse orally with standard telephones and radios to receive and communicate information to employees and the public.
- Agility/Movement - Ability to lift, push, pull, and manipulate tools, equipment, supplies, and other objects often weighing upwards to 80 pounds.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS:

High school graduation, GED, or equivalent education preparation and ability to deal with the public courteously and effectively. Three years experience related to road construction and maintenance involving the equipment regularly assigned to employees classified as Equipment Operator IV.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

CDL as required by state law with various endorsements.
